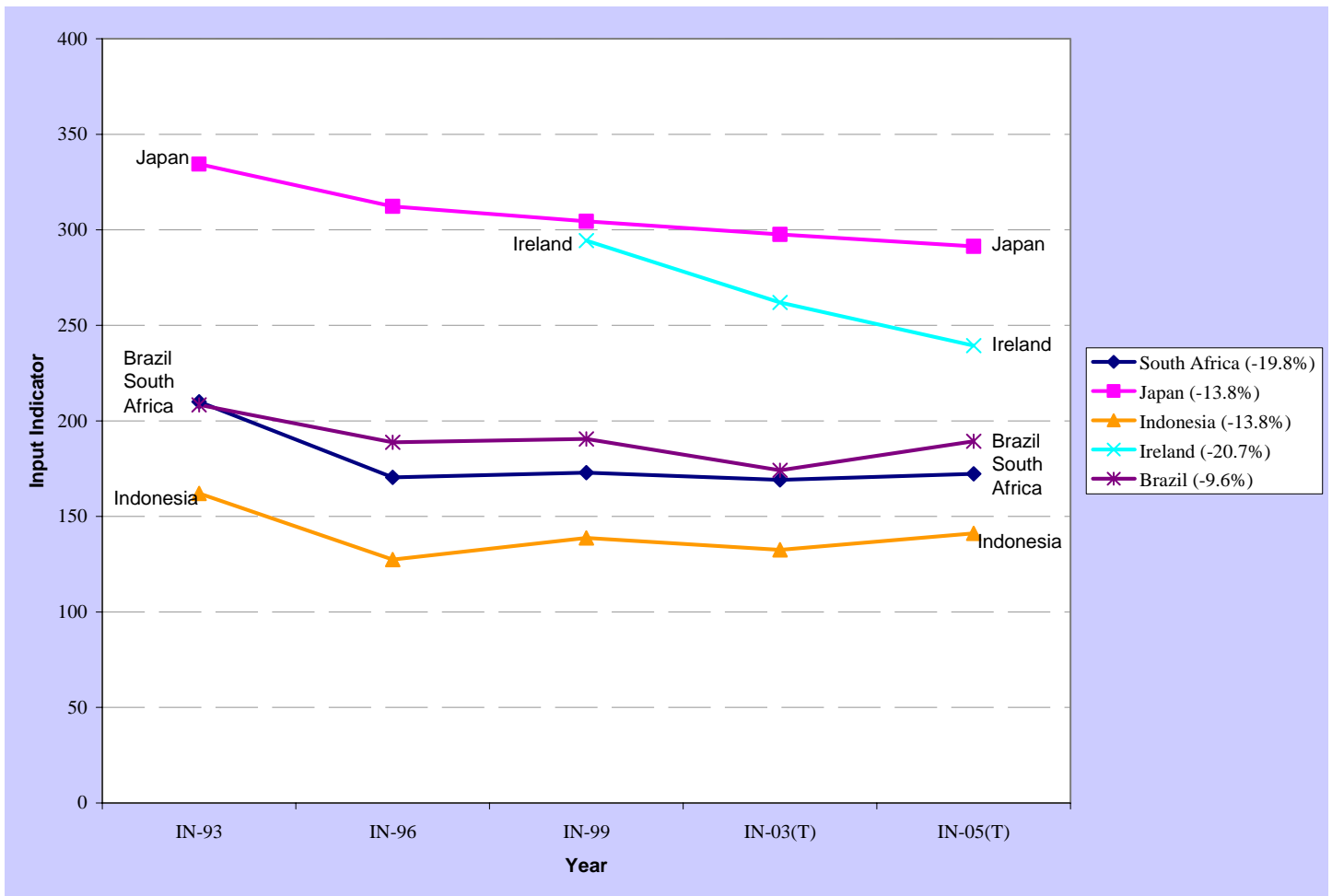


**Figure 32: INPUT, Traditional -- INPUT (T) 1993-2005: Greatest Percent Declines (- 10% or more)**



*Note:* INPUT adds together our four Input (leading) indicators – NO, SE, TI, and PC -- each of which is an average of components scaled 0-100, so the potential INPUT range is 0-400.

This graph is a selected picture of the countries that show at least a 10% decline in INPUT indicator value (Traditional formulation) over time from their first score (usually 1993) to 2005. South Africa (-19.8%) shows the most significant decline from 1993 to 2005, however in the time period of 1999 to 2005, Ireland (-20.7%) surpasses South Africa in percent decline.
